

Transport By Bus

From the City: The closest stop is right outside 10 Stirling Highway, Stop No. 10391. Bus routes 102, 107 & 103

Other options:

From Scarborough / Northern Suburbs to Fremantle: Alight bus 99 at Stop No. 10391 outside 10 Stirling Highway.
