

TERMS OF REFERENCE: COMMUNITY LEGAL EDUCATION WORKERS (CLEWS)

Membership:

Membership is through a process of self-nomination and is open to anyone from a member centre who is interested in these issues.

Role/Purpose:

The Network facilitates discussion and collaboration between member centres that deliver community legal education (CLE) in Western Australia and fosters collaboration with other legal service providers including Legal Aid WA and the Aboriginal Legal Service.

The Network is an important source of experience and expertise for the CLCA (WA) and the Association is committed to informing and consulting with the Network about relevant issues.

The Network is the link to the national CLECD Network (Community Legal Education and Community Development Network).

Convenor:

Members of the Network will decide at the first meeting held each year whether to elect a Convenor or Co-Convenors.

Meetings:

The Network will meet regularly – four times a year, with the capacity to call additional meetings on an as needs basis.

Reporting:

The Sub Committee is able to make a formal report to the CLCA (WA) Executive, which will be considered at the Committee meeting. Reports from Networks will also be a standing agenda item for all General Meetings..

Review:

These Terms of Reference were adopted by the Executive Committee on April 20, 2017 and will be reviewed, initially after a period of one year, and then subsequently after a period of three years.
